

CLIP2Go and GPS

You can add GPS and mapping capabilities to your CLIP2Go. This will allow you to do 2 things.

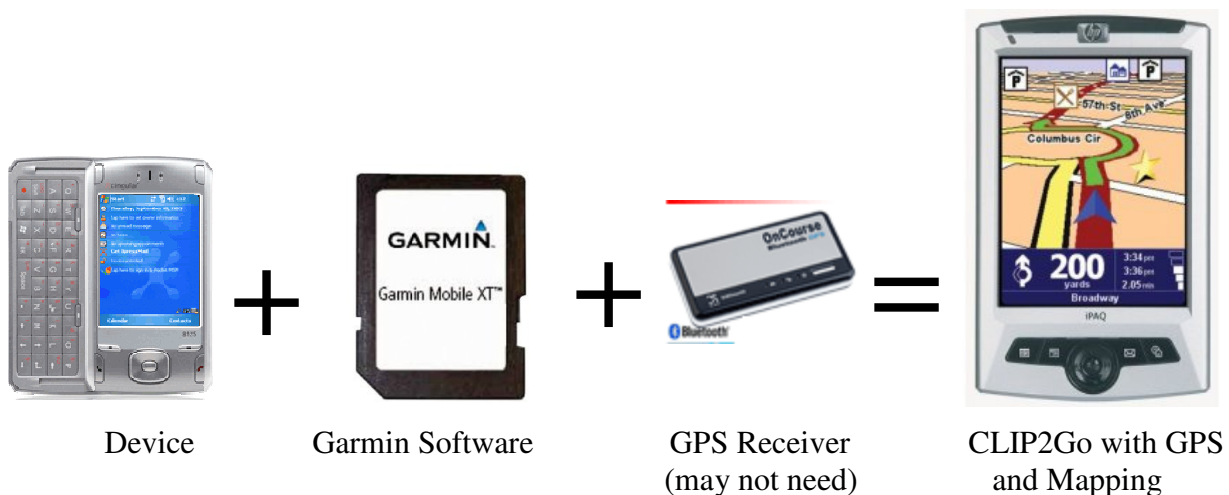
1. When the crew presses the Start button for a job the actual Latitude and Longitude is captured. This means they can not be at 7-11 and start the job. This location can be seen using Microsoft MapPoint in the customers history. It can also track the crews during the day which can be replayed in CLIP using Microsoft MapPoint.

2. It will give the crew directions to the next property from their current position.

Note: This is not a real time system. The data must be downloaded to see where they were

What do you need?

1. CLIP2Go program (only available through CLIP Partner Program)
2. A Windows Mobile 5/6 device with TOUCH SCREEN that has Bluetooth (most units do) or a built in GPS receiver. Usually you can upgrade your cell phone to one of these type units. (Note: At last check Verizon's GPS is locked to 3rd party software so you must get a GPS receiver for those devices)
3. Garmin Mobile XT (Part Number: 010-11034-00) software . This is not the units you see in the store. This is the software that runs on those units, it is sold installed on a SD card.. You will need to buy this online because most stores do not carry it.. You will also need to purchase a copy for each device. (Amazon.com or Garmin.com had this for \$89-\$99)
4. If your device does not have a built in GPS receiver you will need an external one. This is a small box about the size of 2 match boxes. This device actually reads the position and sends the data to the Garmin software via Bluetooth. These receivers are placed on the dash board and normally have cigarette adapter for hours of long use. This can purchased from any vendor. Any brand should work.



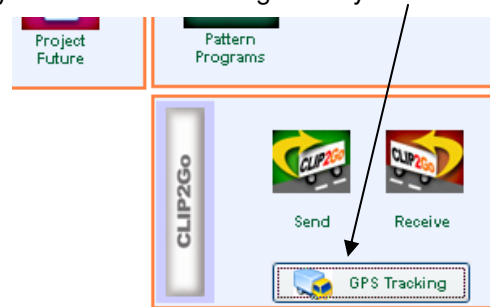
CLIP2Go and GPSTracking

Requires:
 CLIPxe
 CLIP2Go
 Garmin
 MapPoint

You can use CLIP2Go to track your employee's movements throughout the day. By setting up CLIP2Go with the interval at which you want it to sample the location (i.e: every minute or every 5 minutes) CLIP2Go will record each position throughout the day into a log that is then downloaded into your CLIP along with all the other information from CLIP2Go.

From the main menu, click on "GPS Tracking" to see where your crews were during the day.

You will see the form that allows you to pick the crew number and the date to see the tracking.



Click on the "See Tracking" button and you will see your Crew's movements for the dates specified.

You can click on the PLAY button to see a quick Replay of your Crew's movements.
