These are the steps to import from Millie 6 for DOS

If we receive the data:

1. Copy the data to the C:\Millie6 Directory. It will not work over the network or if you place it in a lower directory.
2. Create a batch file that is named Millie.bat and place this line in it: PDOXRUN -CODEPOOL 1000 - STACK 14 MAIN
3. Run the Batch file in a DOS Window
4. Get through all the notes and warnings by pressing OK
5. When you see the Customer List Choose the Reports Menu option
6. Choose the labels option
7. Choose the Billing address
8. Choose Single
9. Choose One Copy
10. Choose Export
11. Type in the name of the new file "millie"
12. Choose dBase
13. Choose dBase III
14. The export is finished.

On the CLIP Side: You need a copy of the CLIP.EXE from 1/13/99 or later. Either Classic or PRO

1. Get into your new CLIP
2. Go to the Dot Prompt
3. Type DO qb_cimp WITH "MI"
4. This will trigger the import function to look for a Millie import file
5. You will be presented with a locate file dialog
6. Find your exported file and choose it
7. CLIP will import all the customers from Millie – this might take a while

What does CLIP import?

1. All customer name and address information
2. Credit limits
3. Customer notes
4. Customer account numbers
